Description: This presentation examines the structural properties and design benefits of channel glass wall systems and their contributions to building aesthetics and performance. Discussions cover various material and design options to enhance channel glass walls' daylighting capabilities, thermal performance, visual and acoustic privacy. Dozens of realized projects are used to illustrate how channel glass wall systems can directly contribute to a building's design, financial, and sustainability goals.
